



Lund Virtual Fishing League Scholarships

1. PURPOSE

The scholarships provided by the Lund Virtual Fishing League are designed to assist in the financial burden put on families. Our hope is to aid randomly selected individuals as a way to say thank you for supporting the Lund Virtual Fishing League. Our goal is not to make this process too restrictive, by doing so we put a lot of trust in the anglers that are awarded the scholarship to attend and finish school. We also do not restrict based off location, so if you attend out of state, we will support that as well.

2. PARTICIPATION AND ELIGIBILITY

Scholarships are awarded at the Fall Fling Open, and are a random draw based on an angler fishing three events, or the last two events of the season.

Scholarships are provided to an individual and not the team

Scholarships funds will be kept for a period of two years, after the student's graduation. If the funds are not used by that time they will be put back into the scholarship fund to be used for other events.

These scholarships are valid for one school year and are not renewable.

3. RESTRICTIONS

Scholarships are to be used for any 4-year Graduate, 2-year Trade, Community College, Lineman, Police, Sheriff, State Patrol, First Responder, or any Fire and Rescue school.
